Interesting, delicious, inexpensive food and drinks? That's possible! Apart from exclusive restaurants and well-known fast foods, Poznań proposes many original culinary solutions for students. The list below offers just a few places for you to explore.

# Express Marché (Stary Browar)

Fresh, varied and, last but not least, very cheap meals, including meat, fish, vegetable, fruits and salads of your own choice. Prices from 10 to 20 PLN, 20 per cent discount for students and during last hour (from 20.00) – 50 per cent discount for all!

# Burger Restaurants

If you are a burger fan (not necessary of those from McDonald's and KFC) you should definitely check Poznań's burger restaurants. Here just a short list of some of them: Food Patrol, Łapu Papu, Święta Krowa, Molly's Grill, 7 Street Bar and Grill, TGI Friday's.

#### Bars

When your budget is rather limited but still you want a good food, don't hesitate to visit some of local bars. Poznań is famous for so called bary mleczne (milk bars) where you can eat your fill for a little price. We recommend especially: Pyra Bar, Pod Kuchcikiem, Pod Arkadami, Pancake Square, Przysmak, Rzepicha or Caritas Bar u Krystyna.

## Green Way

Vegetarian or not, you may taste a wide range of "green food": soups, salads, pancakes, curry with tofu, Indian coftas, Mexican enchiladas and fresh, natural cocktails and juices.

## Basilium

Located in heart of the city, Basilium offers more than 150 types of Polish beer as well as a wide range of wines and beer cocktails. Unique atmosphere and interesting interior makes it a perfect place for meetings with friends.

#### Brovaria

Exceptional local in the Old Market Square proposes variety of beers from its own restaurant brewery. Wheat beer, honey beer, pils, delicious menu – all this together with a magnificent view of the City Hall and its surroundings.
